(Poster color is not always required.)

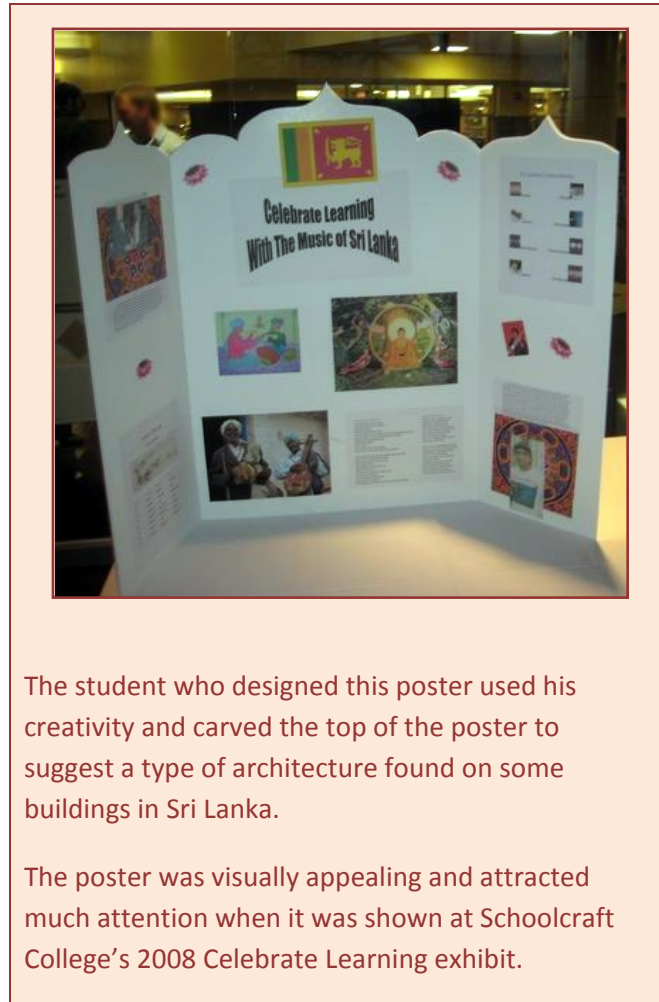
Unless you can appropriately answer "Yes" to all six statements, your poster will not be accepted and you will receive a 0.0 for the assignment.¹⁵
